

# Felted Coffee Cup Cozy

Crocheted and felted coffee cup cozy.

## Directions

Ch 28, join to first st.

**Row 1:** Ch 2, hdc in first st and in each to end of row. 28 hdc. Join to first hdc, ignoring ch 2.

**Row 2:** Ch 2, (hdc in next 13 st, 2 hdc in next st) around. 30 hdc. Join to first hdc, ignoring ch 2.

**Row 3:** Ch 2, (hdc in next 14 st, 2 hdc in next st) around. 32 hdc. Join to first hdc, ignoring ch 2.

**Row 4:** Ch 2, (hdc in next 15 st, 2 hdc in next st) around. 34 hdc. Join to first hdc, ignoring ch 2.

**Row 5:** Ch 2, (hdc in next 16 st, 2 hdc in next st) around. 34 hdc. Join to first hdc, ignoring ch 2.

**Row 6:** Ch 2, (hdc in next 17 st, 2 hdc in next st) around. 36 hdc. Join to first hdc, ignoring ch 2.

**Row 7:** Ch 2, (hdc in next 18 st, 2 hdc in next st) around. 38 hdc. Join to first hdc, ignoring ch 2.

**Row 8:** Ch 3, (2 fldc in each stitch) around. 76 fldc. Join to first fldc, ignoring ch 3. Bind off.

## Finishing

Felt and shape over coffee cup to dry. Pinch ruffle into v-shape along entire edge.



## Finished Size

10" circumference by 3" tall

## Yarn

Dk weight wool, 1 skein

## Hook

Size J (6 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge

## Gauge

Working loosely, 11 hdc and 11 rows = 4"  
Check your gauge before you begin

## Special Stitches

*fldc (front loop double crochet):* Yarn over hook, insert hook into the front loop only of the indicated stitch, yarn over hook and pull through a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over hook and draw through two loops on hook, yarn over hook and draw through two remaining loops.
